"We greet each other, we embrace each other. What is our commitment? To improve our life and improve it with honorable, dignified and worthy work, always sovereign, always dignified, always free in love and blessings.

How precious our Nicaraguan mothers are, how brave we are, children of Rubén Darío, of Sandino, children of our Lord God, in this heroic Nicaragua full of love. Our heart always blesses and gives thanks to Jesus Christ, to our God, to our Holy Spirit, to Mary our most Holy Mother, for what we are, for what we are doing and will be doing in our everyday efforts to make the dream of brotherhood, work, security, prosperity come true in places where our mothers give us inspiration, encouragement, stimulus, devotion and hope for all", she added.

Likewise, she referred to the number of families going to the cemeteries today to visit and decorate with flowers the tombs of their mothers who are already at peace.

"Blessed mothers, from mother to mother, with the mother with whom we share a vision of the future, of a safe, peaceful dawn. Blessed mothers, from mother to mother we love each other and we continue along the path of work, tranquility and prosperity," she said.

## More than 114 million Córdobas to be invested in School Infrastructure this Week

31 May

Authorities of the Ministry of Education (MINED) presented a schedule of activities to be implemented this week to celebrate the Week of the Child.

Mr. Salvador Vanegas, presidential advisor for educational issues, said that throughout the month of June new works and projects will be undertaken to improve school infrastructure. [Specifically] work will be carried out to rehabilitate 18 study centers.

"The works will reach a total investment of 114 million 299 thousand córdobas in several departments of the country, including Boaco, Chinandega, Chontales, León, Managua, Masaya, Rivas, and Matagalpa", he said.

Likewise, local congresses will be held with the participation of students, teachers and parents to assess the progress in education and how education will look in the future.

"We are going to hold a forum with teachers from the Normal Schools, who will evaluate the improvements and advances in the training of future teachers. There will also be a videoconference with school library staff to recommend new initiatives," he said.

## M&R reports 89 percent of Nicaraguans surveyed disapprove of foreign interference

1 June

A total of 89% of those polled expressed their disagreement with foreign governments interfering in Nicaragua's internal affairs, according to data from M&R Consultores.

The opinion survey on "Nicaraguans and their perspectives on the international scene", states that 91.3% of those polled affirmed that Nicaragua, in order to progress as a country, must have the freedom to decide what it wants as a nation, without external interference.

Regarding the stance of the leaders of Mexico, Honduras and Bolivia and 12 Caribbean countries not to attend the Summit of the Americas, if the United States fails to invite Nicaragua, Cuba and Venezuela, 70% of Nicaraguans support this initiative.

"The majority of Nicaraguans, 8 out of 10, expressed their disagreement with the United States' decision not to invite or to exclude [certain] countries from the Summit of the Americas", highlighted Raúl Obregón, Director of M&R Consultores.

The continued relevance of General Augusto C. Sandino's adage, "Any ruler imposed by a foreign power will only represent and defend foreign interests and never those of his country", holds true, and is supported by 78.8% of Nicaraguans.

In the survey on the perception of security in Central American countries, 85.4% affirm that Nicaragua is very safe, and 87.1% affirm that the country provides the conditions for foreign investment.

Both Ambassadors will commence their period of [diplomatic] representation in the near future.

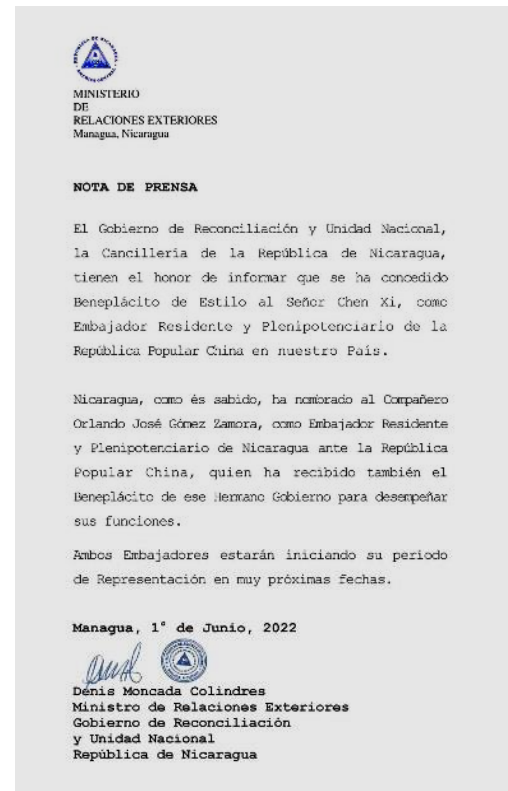

## Nicaragua asks to respect the rights of Mother Earth in Stockholm

3 June

A Delegation of the Nicaraguan Government is participating in the Stockholm+50 Meeting: “Stockholm+50: A healthy planet for the prosperity of all – our responsibility, our opportunity,” taking place in Stockholm, Sweden from 2-3 June 2022, in celebration of the 50th anniversary of the first United Nations Earth Summit.

The Meeting was opened by Carl XVI Gustaf, King of Sweden; Mr. António Guterres, Secretary General of the United Nations; Mr. Abdulla Shahid, President of the UN Assembly; Mr. Collen Vixen, President of the UN Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC); Ms. Inger Andersen, Director of UNEP; Mrs. Magdalena Andersson, Prime Minister of Sweden and Vice-President of the Stockholm+50 Meeting, and Mr. Uhuru Kenyatta, President of Kenya and Vice-President of the Stockholm+50 Meeting, with the participation of ministers, vice-ministers and delegates from 198 UN Parties.

The Nicaraguan Delegation read out its Message at national level, emphasizing the urgency of halting environmental degradation and transforming the development model to one that defends Mother Earth, which implies a cosmo-centric World, where Nature and Human Beings are a whole, "the entirety of Mother Earth".

As always, our Delegation conveyed the fraternal greetings of our People, of our Government of National Reconciliation and Unity and our firm commitment in the fight against environmental degradation, climate change on the basis of shared but differentiated responsibilities and equity, facing drought, advancing the neutrality of land degradation and accelerating its sustainable management, knowing that fertile lands are fundamental for biodiversity and ecosystems, which feed us, clothe us, protect us and are the very backbone of a prosperous national and global economy.
