Nicaragua reaffirms that it is unacceptable for Colonialists to attempt to impose their hegemony

The Special Representative of the President for the Russian Federation, *Compañero* Laureano Ortega Murillo, participated in the forum on modern practices of Neocolonialism, organized by the United Russia Party, informed Vice President *Compañera* Rosario Murillo.

"This morning, also at 6 o'clock in the morning, we participated with political parties from a number of countries in Africa, Asia, Europe and Latin America, in the forum to condemn modern practices of neocolonialism. The Forum was convened by the United Russia Party and was chaired by comrade Dimitriy Medvedev, who is the Vice President of the Security Council of the Russian Federation and has also been President and Prime Minister of that great country", explained the Vice-president.

"Algeria, Brazil, China, Cuba, the African National Congress (ANC), Indonesia, Laos, Lebanon, Mozambique, Myanmar, Nicaragua, Pakistan, Russia, Zimbabwe, Syria and Venezuela, through their parties and movements participated in these discussions where we all agreed on the need to strengthen the unity between our countries as we go forward fighting against the new neo-colonialist practices, fighting to reduce inequalities, fighting and rejecting the manipulation of the international political, financial and communicational mechanisms that threaten the sovereignty of our peoples, fighting to achieve the elimination of the hegemony of the dollar as [the world's] foreign reserve currency and to advance in the construction of a multipolar world of dialogue and peace, fraternity, justice and solidarity", added Compañera [Rosario].

Members of the *Casa de la Soberanía* participated in the VI International Seminar "Latin America and the Caribbean, and China: Conditions and Challenges in the 21st Century" from 29 - 31 May online, in which 110 papers were presented in four thematic areas, in addition to six keynote speeches.

The four themes covered were: economy, trade and investment; political and international relations; natural resources and environment, and; history, culture and Chinese language learning.

The seminar was organized by the Latin American and Caribbean Academic Network on China. During the opening remarks the general coordinator of the Network, Dr. Enrique Dussel Peters, expressed:

"China's presence globally and in Latin America and the Caribbean (LAC) is undeniable in any socio-economic area and in all countries of the region, even in those with which China does not have diplomatic relations. The launch of the Belt and Road Initiative in 2013, as well as the growing number of Confucius Institutes in the region have also increased cooperation in every conceivable field between LAC and China. Both LAC and China have been establishing public, private and academic initiatives, albeit with difficulties, for a reciprocal understanding; particularly significant is the growing educational academic and exchange between young people and new generations of students."

The dialogue exchange seeks to learn more about relations between Latin America and the Caribbean, and China, in terms of bilateral and multilateral policies, natural resources and the environment, as well as the analysis of culture, history and Chinese language learning.

Nicaragua participates in International Infrastructure Investment and Construction Forum

On Thursday, June 1st, the Fourteenth International Forum for Investment in Infrastructure and Construction, organized in the city of Macao, South of the People's Republic of China, was officially inaugurated.

Within the framework of this important International Forum, the IX China-Latin America Infrastructure Forum was also held, in which the Nicaraguan Delegation, through Comrade General Oscar Mojica, offered words of welcome to the participants of the Forum.

In his speech, Comrade General Mojica, conveyed to the Governmental and Business Authorities present, the Solidarity Greetings of our President, Daniel Ortega and our Vice President, Rosario Murillo, to the People and Government of the Sister People's Republic of China. In addition, General Mojica congratulated the President of China, Comrade Xi Jinping, for the achievements of his people and Government in terms of economic and digital integration, transition to green energy, trade and solidarity support, strengthening international connectivity, among other aspects, which are materialized in the Belt and Road Initiative, the flagship project of the Government of President Xi.

Ambassador of the State of Kuwait meets with representatives of the Government of Nicaragua

The Concurrent Ambassador of the State of Kuwait to Nicaragua, Salah Alhaddad, participated this Wednesday in important meetings with representatives of the Government of Nicaragua, in order to strengthen and reinforce cooperation and brotherly ties between the two countries.

The Minister of Finance and Public Credit, Ivan Acosta, stressed that the visit of Ambassador Salah Alhaddad, "has to do with the cooperation ties of our countries, which have been vital for the financing of the hospital in Chinandega and also to review future portfolios of cooperation".

Mr. Acosta also commented that "we are progressing very quickly, we have been informed about the financing of the bridge in the North Caribbean, important bridges of communication in our country, which will improve the communication of the Indigenous Peoples with the rest of the country. This is relevant, it is already in the process of approval. There is also the Feasibility Study of the Network of Teacher Training Colleges for the Ministry of Education, which will allow with this study, to manage a new project in 2024".

Acosta said that the Kuwait Development Fund is a very important partner for the people and Government of Nicaragua "and we appreciate the visit of the ambassador, who comes to express the commitment of the Kuwaiti people with the people of Nicaragua".

Nicaragua will attend Erdoğan's installation of new term as president of Turkey

The Foreign Minister of Nicaragua, Denis Moncada, will be representing the people and Government of Nicaragua, at the installation ceremony of the new presidential term of brother Recep Tayyip Erdoğan in the Republic of Turkey, informed Vice President Rosario Murillo.

"Our Foreign Minister is traveling to represent our people and Government, to represent all of us at the inauguration, the swearing in ceremony of the new presidential term of brother Erdoğan, there in sister Turkey. This ceremony will take place on June 3rd. Denis is already traveling there, he has just been at the inauguration in Nigeria and he will be back, I think by Sunday, he will already be with us again," she said.

"So, on the one hand, we announce that we have received the Letters of Credence [Credentials] from Ambassador Salah Alhaddad, ambassador of the State of Kuwait concurrent from Mexico and we are getting ready to attend, expressing our gratitude, of course, for the invitation to attend the inauguration, after his great [electoral] victory, of the president of Turkey, our brother Erdoğan", she added.
