Nicaragua receives humanitarian aid in wheat and urea from the People's Republic of China

The People's Republic of China delivered 1,332 metric tons of wheat and 2,250 tons of urea in humanitarian aid to Nicaragua.

The delivery of humanitarian assistance was presided over by *Compañero* Laureano Ortega Murillo, Presidential Advisor for the Promotion of Investment, Trade and International Cooperation, and by Mr. Chen Xi, Ambassador of the People's Republic of China in Nicaragua.

Nicaragua and Russia approve an Agreement on the use of Atomic Energy for Peaceful Purposes

The National Assembly approved the agreement between the Government of the Republic of Nicaragua and the Government of the Russian Federation, on Cooperation in the Field of Non-Energy Applications of Atomic Energy for Peaceful Purposes.

The favorable opinion was presented by the president of the Foreign Affairs Committee, Representative Iris Montenegro, who stressed that the agreement does not contradict the Constitution of the Republic, granting the go-ahead for its approval.

In Latin America and the Caribbean, countries such as Argentina, Brazil, Venezuela, Mexico, Cuba, Bolivia, Paraguay, Uruguay, among others, have approved legislation on the use of non-energy applications of atomic energy, to improve aspects related to health, agriculture, pest control, better land use and many other tasks to improve the quality of life of their societies.

This Tuesday, the National Assembly approved an Agreement between the Government of Nicaragua and the Government of the Russian Federation on Cooperation in the Field of Non-Energy Applications of Atomic Energy for Peaceful Purposes.

“The technological applications of atomic energy are used in agriculture, to make our agriculture more efficient. Through the handling of the molecules, it is possible to determine, for example, the minimum amount of fertilizer necessary for agricultural use, thus reducing costs and the ecological impact of the use of these fertilizers,” said Deputy Wálmaro Gutiérrez discussing the benefits of using non-energy applications of atomic energy for peaceful purposes.

Likewise, he highlighted that, thanks to the use of this type of applications in many countries around the world, food is now better preserved, allowing us to greatly reduce the loss of foodstuffs and with this, more populations [can] guarantee their food security.

National Assembly approves Bi-national Agreement between Nicaragua and Honduras

The National Assembly approved this Tuesday the binational agreement between the Secretariat of State in the Health Office of Honduras and the Ministry of Health of Nicaragua, for implementing joint cross-border interventions for the elimination of malaria based on community law.

The doctor and Representative Melvin Agurcia Perrot, explained that this binational protocol will allow both States to carry out actions and health plans aimed at eradicating malaria in the communities located between the border of Honduras and Nicaragua.

This binational agreement was signed in the municipality of Ocotal, Nueva Segovia, within the framework of the agreement signed by the Council of Ministers of Health of Central America "Regional Initiative for the Elimination of Malaria" which instructed the countries of Guatemala, El Salvador, Honduras, Costa Rica and Nicaragua to sign cross-border binational agreements for the elimination of malaria.

These agreements must define the actors, mechanisms, and periodicity for routine analysis and exchange of epidemiological, entomological, operational information, and population movements that affect cross-border malaria.

National Assembly approves the Binational Agreement between the Ministry of Health of the Republic of Honduras and the Ministry of Health of Nicaragua for the Implementation of Cross-Border Joint Interventions for the Elimination of Malaria Based on Community Law.

Nicaragua is at the vanguard in Central America in intrauterine fetal surgery

Since 2021, Nicaragua has made history in maternal-fetal medicine, becoming the first country in the Central American region to perform fetal surgeries at the Bertha Calderón Roque Hospital, a national reference for the comprehensive care of women, with the support of the Government led by president Daniel Ortega and Vice President Rosario Murillo.

Dr. Carmen Marina Cruz, director of the Bertha Calderón Hospital, indicated that this project was born from the heart of Comandante Daniel Ortega and Compañera Rosario Murillo, as well as from the commitment of the Ministry of Health to provide care to patients who were diagnosed from the maternal womb some kind of malformation.

He recalled that the first surgery performed marked a milestone in the history of perinatal medicine and a new era in this type of surgical intervention in Nicaragua.

"The first intrauterine fetal surgery was performed in March 2021. From that date to the present we have carried out 168 intrauterine fetal procedures and 94 conatal surgeries," Cruz said.

Conatal surgeries are those performed on the newborn immediately at birth since the fetus was captured in a very advanced pregnancy and the procedure could not be performed inside the uterus.

Nicaragua is the only country that monitors pregnancy at term and performs corrective surgery immediately after it leaves the womb after doing the respective analysis and studies on the baby, in a maximum time of 2 to 4 hours.
