President of the Islamic Republic of Iran to arrive in Nicaragua next Tuesday

On Tuesday, June 13th, the President of the Islamic Republic of Iran, Ebrahim Raisi, will be arriving in Nicaragua, together with a large delegation, announced Vice President Rosario Murillo.

"*Compañeros, compañeras*, next Tuesday, His Excellency Dr. Ebrahim Raisi, President of the Islamic Republic of Iran, will be arriving together with the Ministers of Health, Economic Cooperation, the Joint Commission, as well as deputies of the Islamic Consultative Assembly," she said.

She added that "the Minister of Energy and Petroleum, the head of the office of the President of the Republic, the Vice-President for Scientific and Technological Affairs and the Knowledge Economy, the Minister of Defense and Logistics of the Armed Forces" will also arrive in the country.

"The delegation, which is very large, will also include delegates from [the ministries of] Agriculture, Economic Relations, Diplomacy, Communication, Foreign Affairs. Tomorrow we will continue presenting our visitors," she concluded.

UNAN-Managua and Kunming University of the People's Republic of China sign Memorandum of Understanding

UNAN-Managua and the Kunming University of Science and Technology of the People's Republic of China signed a memorandum of understanding for academic exchange and the establishment of the Confucius Institute.

The MOU signing ceremony was presided over by Ms. Ramona Rodríguez, Rector of UNAN-Managua and President of the National Council of Universities (CNU), and Mr. Hao Kun, Deputy Director General of the Foreign Affairs Office of the Yunnan Provincial People's Government, who heads the large delegation from that province of the People's Republic of China.

Ms. Ramona Rodríguez said that UNAN-Leon also received a delegation from Yunnan Normal University.

The UNAN-Managua received a delegation from the Kunming University of Science and Technology of the People's Republic of China, with which they signed a memorandum of understanding.

"Through the establishment of the Confucius Institute in our UNAN-Managua, we will be able to strengthen our ties of academic collaboration that will allow us to exchange students, professors, and joint research," she said.

Nicaragua at the Board of Governors of the International Atomic Energy Agency

The Government of National Reconciliation and Unity (GRUN), through its Embassy in Austria, participated in the 1672nd meeting of the Board of Governors of the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA), which took place from 5-8 June 2023 in Austria.

The meeting was chaired by Mr. Ivo Sramek, Governor of the Czech Republic, and Mr. Rafael Mariano Grossi, Director General of the IAEA, who referred to the 2022 Annual Report, the strengthening of the Technical Cooperation activities of 149 countries, the Nuclear Verification and the Safeguards Implementation Report.

Nicaragua, with the support of the IAEA, is implementing national and regional projects in the areas of Human Health, Energy, Food Security, Radiation Safety, Environment, among others, with the participation of more than eleven State institutions, making peaceful use of science and nuclear technologies.

The Delegation of the Government of Nicaragua was represented by Compañera Sabra Murillo Centeno, Permanent Representative to the IAEA, who reiterated the support of the Nicaraguan Government for the work of the Agency and to the Director General and urged compliance with the international non-proliferation regime supported by the Non-Proliferation Treaty (NPT), in order to maintain international peace and security.

The 2023 Gaspar García Laviana Port, Moyogalpa - Ometepe project is presented

The Government of Nicaragua, through the National Port Company (EPN), presented the 2023 Gaspar García Laviana Moyogalpa - Ometepe Port project in the department of Rivas.

Virgilio Silva, executive president of EPN, said that in keeping with the instructions of President Daniel Ortega and Vice President Rosario Murillo, construction of the national tourism investment project will begin on June 20th.

"We have already estimated the cost, approximately 2 million dollars, and already have the resources to immediately undertake this investment; Compañera (Rosario Murillo) mentioned it yesterday, and we will begin on June 20th," he announced.

Silva stated that they are already working on the plans, "we are already going to take the materials we have in San Jorge, on the 16th we will be there with the necessary equipment".

The executive president of EPN mentioned that the investment they will make in the project should be recouped in 5 years, according to the studies they have conducted.

"We are clear that Ometepe Island is an oasis of peace, and that many international tourists visit this place because in addition to security, there is peace, and that is of vital importance for our country", he said.
