Nicaragua Commemorates the 44th Anniversary of the Triumph of the Sandinista Popular Revolution

In the Square of National Dignity, President Daniel Ortega Saavedra and Vice President Rosario Murillo presided over the celebration of the 44th anniversary of the triumph of the Sandinista Popular Revolution.

The event was attended by representatives of peoples and governments from Africa including Angola, Burkina Faso, Ghana, Mozambique, and Nigeria; from Eurasia, including Abkhazia, Belarus, Russian Federation, and South Ossetia; and from Asia and the Middle East, including the Islamic Republic of Iran, the Democratic People's Republic of Korea, the Democratic People's Republic of Laos, the State of Palestine, and from Latin America, including Cuba, Honduras, Mexico and Venezuela.

"This celebration is presided over by the heroic Nicaraguan families from all over our sacred geography. And it is presided over by our youth from throughout our blessed Nicaragua who are also a divine treasure," said the Vice President.

General Zeledón's legacy, theme of the 5th meeting of the Permanent Forum on Sovereignty and Peace

With the participation of national and international partners, teachers and students, the Casa de la Soberanía Miguel d'Escoto Brockmann, organized this Tuesday, 18 July, a conference "From the Knox Note to the Heroic Exploits of Benjamin Zeledón in Defense of Nation's Sovereignty", delivered by Dr. Edgard Palazio Galo, executive of the Directorate for University Outreach and professor of the Department of Social and Political Sciences at the UNAN-Managua.

The activity, framed within the 44th anniversary of the triumph of the Sandinista Popular Revolution, is part of the Permanent Forum for the Defense of Sovereignty and Peace, coordinated by the House of Sovereignty for the purpose of promoting dialogue, the free debate of ideas and critical thinking that contribute towards a deeper understanding of contemporary socio-cultural, political and economic dynamics.

During this fifth encounter of the Forum, Dr. Palazio referred to the struggle of General Benjamín Zeledon, especially the period 1909-1912, which was not exempt from attempts at imperialist domination to usurp our national sovereignty. Regarding 1912, Palazio emphasized the U.S. military occupation and the uprising which General Zeledon participated in until 4 October, when he was killed in combat during the Battle of Coyotepe.

The academic also emphasized "since 4 September, when Luis Mena laid down his arms and shamefully surrendered, General Benjamín Zeledon took up the fight". Likewise, he points out that for the first time in our national history a different social and political discourse emerged in which the meaning and philosophy of "homeland" and "defense of our sovereignty" prevailed, consistent with the deeds of General Zeledon.

Nicaragua and Belarus sign a series of important cooperation agreements

This Thursday, a series of program and project agreements were signed between the delegation of the Republic of Nicaragua, headed by Foreign Minister Denis Moncada, and the delegation of Belarus, chaired by Foreign Minister Sergei Aleinik.

Compañero Laureano Ortega Murillo, Presidential Advisor for the Promotion of Investments, Trade and International Cooperation, expressed that the visit of their brother, the Foreign Minister of the Republic of Belarus, comrade Sergey Aleinik is coming to its conclusion.

"He has come with a large delegation to accompany us in our celebration of the 44th anniversary of the Sandinista People's Revolution. Taking advantage of these visits, a series of meetings have been held with the Cabinet of our Government, the work team delegated by our President (Commander Daniel Ortega), to coordinate programs of cooperation and projects for mutual benefit and for the benefit, of course, of the people of Nicaragua," he stressed.


The agreements in detail

Laureano mentioned that a series of important agreements were signed, including an agreement to establish a Joint Commission for Economic and Commerce Cooperation to promote trade, investments, exchanges between Belarusian and Nicaraguan companies and promote understanding between our peoples.

"We have also signed the agreement on the Mutual Lifting of Requirements between the citizens of Belarus and Nicaragua, promoting trade, investments, scientific-technical cooperation," he mentioned.

Dr. Gustavo Porras, President of the National Assembly met this Thursday with Dr. Ebrahim Azizi, President of the National Security and Foreign Policy Commission of the Islamic Consultative Assembly of Iran, who is visiting Nicaragua.

At the end of the meeting held in the Board of Directors' meeting room in the "Presbyter Tomás Ruíz" Building, the president of the National Security and Foreign Policy Commission of the Islamic Consultative Assembly of Iran described the meeting as a fruitful and important exchange between the two nations.

"In the framework continuing our visit for the [44th] anniversary of the Revolution, some meetings were arranged including a meeting with the President of the National Assembly. We had quite a fruitful meeting with the Speaker of Parliament," he said.

He stressed that there are characteristics and points in convergence between Iran and Nicaragua, "mainly points in common from a political point of view, a vision that is very important and fundamental for us, that is our common vision in the fight against imperialism, likewise space exists for deeping the bilateral relations between Iran and Nicaragua".

Comrade Ebrahim Azizi highlighted that these shared views are the primary basis for the flourishing and growth in different sectors, "from the health sector, sanitation, business sector, trade exchanges and the security sector".

Nicaragua and Abkhazia sign Cooperation Activities Program for 2023

In the spirit of further strengthening the bilateral relations between the friendly countries of Nicaragua and Abkhazia, the signing of a Program of Cooperation Activities for 2023 took place.

The signing of the document took place at Nicaragua's Ministry of Foreign Affairs. The signing was carried out by Foreign Minister Denis Moncada for Nicaragua; Mr. Beslan Dzhopua, Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Agriculture for the Republic of Abkhazia, and Mr. Iraklii Tuzhba, Deputy Minister of Foreign Affairs of that nation, accompanied by Mr. Iraklii Tuzhba.

Foreign Minister Moncada explained that this cooperation between the two countries will be in the fields of Education, Culture, Sports and Youth Policy.

"This Program of Activities represents a mutual commitment that will have a positive impact on the lives of our young people, by providing spaces and exchange opportunities for their cultural and educational development, fostering their inclusion and active participation in the development of our societies", he acknowledged.

In addition, in the field of education, it will provide opportunities to share experiences, lessons learned and foster learning between students and teachers from both countries.
