The President of the Republic during the military parade greeted the members of the diplomatic corps invited to the ceremony, where the different branches and military vehicles of the Armed Forces passed military review. Dr. Carlos Emilio Lopez reflects on the history of Nicaragua's independence struggle

Continuing with its activities of the Permanent Forum for the Defense of Sovereignty and Peace, that the Miguel d'Escoto Brockmann House of Sovereignty has been organizing since March 22, held its seventh meeting this morning in hybrid format with the conference entitled The Popular Sandinista Revolution and True Independence, a lecture delivered by Dr. Carlos Emilio Lopez Hurtado, representative of the Alianza Unida Nicaragua Triunfa (United Alliance Nicaragua Triumphs) and a member of Nicaragua's National Assembly.

The event was inaugurated by Dr. Luis Alfredo Lobato Blanco, Vice Rector General of the UNAN-Managua and Director of the House of Sovereignty, who presented the professional and political background of the guest speaker. He also stressed the relevance of today's topic, since it coincides with the celebrations of the National Patriotic holidays of September, in which the history of the country's struggles is remembered and the values of selfdetermination, patriotism and sovereignty are reaffirmed.

Dr. López's dissertation focused on three distinct areas: Historical;, Constitutional, Legal; and Political and Human Rights. In this regard, he referred to the first independence of Central America and, therefore, of the homeland of General Sandino, which was formalized in an act which was signed on 15 September 1821. However, he stated that this was a historical event in which there was a [simple] transition as to who would be the new oppressor, "previously it was the Spaniards, dispossessors of our wealth and destroyers of our culture and spirituality, then the growing bourgeoisie that continued with the exploitation from 1821 to 1979 and from 1990 to 2006", he said.

"The struggle against German fascism: history repeats itself in Ukraine", was the title of the conference delivered this morning by journalist and international analyst Fabrizio Casari, who addressed the origin of the Russia/Ukraine conflict and the interests of the United States reflected in its economic, political and military manipulation in an attempt to perpetuate its hegemonic and imperialist model.

Compañero Casari emphasized that the conflict arises from the legitimate identification of the citizens and annexation of the territories of Donetsk and Lugansk to the Russian Federation, a reason that led to the polarization, manipulation and interference of the United States and the European Union in the territory, as well as in the spaces of international law in order to construct a favorable scenario after losing status as a economic power following world the [impressive] growth of Russia, China and other countries that have distanced themselves from these hegemonic powers and have supported the formation of the BRICS+, with the aim of establishing equality in world economic growth.

He said that the internationalization of the conflict has also demonstrated the intervention of the North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO) as a US tool to apply military pressure to destroy Russia politically and militarily, and as an indecent [US] response to the constant growth of this nation, which today is one of the world's main producers of food and oil derivatives.

Nicaragua participates in China Agricultural Industry Trade and Investment Fair

Yesterday, September 6, the Diplomatic Mission of Nicaragua participated as a special guest at the Fifteenth China Agro-processing Industry Investment and Trade Fair, held in Zhumadian City, Henan Province.

This annual event, which is the largest in China's agricultural sector, is organized by the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Affairs, the Zhumadian City Hall and the People's Government of Henan Province, and is themed "Improving the Processing of Agricultural Products and Advances of China's Rural Industry".

The fair included 120 exhibition booths, where more than 40 countries and local and foreign companies presented their products, equipment and technologies, in order to position them in the Chinese market. The Nicaraguan delegation thanked the organizers for the invitation, highlighting that "Nicaragua has historically been recognized as the breadbasket of Central America, being the main producer of meat, coffee, corn, dairy, rice and beans in the region; producing more than 90% of the food it consumes, eradicating hunger and achieving our food security goals".

Nicaragua, with a score of 90.3%, is positioned as one of the countries with the highest index of government management capacity, as reflected in the results of the Panopticon of Public Opinion (M&R POP) Government Management Approval of the Americas, corresponding to the 5th Wave of the second quarter of 2023.

M&R POP Americas Government Management Approval was conducted in 19 countries, 12 by M&R Consultores survey and 7 by secondary sources research, based on public, reliable and credible surveys, available on the internet, with a total sample of 6,621. The General Manager of M&R Consultores, Raúl Obregón, explained that the main purpose of this work, which is carried out three times a year, is to find out the level of approval enjoyed by the countries of the American continent.
