Nicaraguan Foreign Minister Denis Moncada participated in meetings and encounters with his counterparts of the Ibero-American Conference, in which a special communiqué was adopted to combat transnational organized crime, informed Compañera Rosario Murillo, Vice President of Nicaragua.

She added that Moncada also participated in the Ministerial Preparatory Meeting for the "Summit of the Future", and "then in the High-Level Meeting on Universal Health Coverage, all of which took place at the United Nations [headquarters]", said the Vice President.

"He participated in a special event that launched a Geopolitical Map of the Aggressions of the Empires against countries, governments, worthy peoples who did not submit, who do not accept, because we do not accept being subjugated to any empire".

"Also, this afternoon Moncada will be meeting with the Prime Minister of St. Vincent and the Grenadines, Coordinator of CELAC, comrade Ralph Everard Gonsalves; with the Foreign Minister of Turkey; and will participate in the United Nations Meeting of the Alliance of Civilizations, as well as the 93rd Anniversary of the National Day of Saudi Arabia, which will bring together the heads of states, prime ministers and foreign ministers participating in the [78th] United Nations General Assembly. This important event will be hosted by the Foreign Minister of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, Prince Faisal Bin Farhan Al Saud," she added.

"We are very pleased with all that Denis has done on this trip, meeting on our behalf with so many peoples, so many governments, and above all, sharing our right, not only the aspiration, for a better world that we all need so much", concluded Compañera Rosario.

UNAN-Managua commemorates the 67th anniversary of the heroic deed of Rigoberto Lopez Perez

This Thursday, 21 September, marks the 67th anniversary of Rigoberto López Pérez's dedication and sacrifice for the freedom of Nicaragua. He was declared a national hero in recognition of his courageous deed carried out in León, when he shot the tyrant Anastasio Somoza García in 1956, thus initiating a new phase of ascent in the revolutionary struggle.

As part of the activities carried out by UNAN-Managua to commemorate this milestone, the Miguel d'Escoto Brockmann House of Sovereignty organized a lecture entitled "Rigoberto López Pérez: The beginning of the End", delivered by Professor José Gerardo Moreno Martínez.

According to the speaker, Rigoberto's heroic deed must be framed in the historical process of National Liberation initiated by General Augusto C. Sandino against the imperialist forces, since the preparations and the action of assassinating the tyrant constituted the firmest decision of struggle of a small group of men who were fully conscious of their duty to the homeland.

"Rigoberto's action was a slap in the face of imperialism and its expansionist, neocolonialist policy of exploitation and domination over the peoples of Latin America and the Caribbean," he said.

Nicaragua ranks first in Central American in control of toxic substances

Nicaragua occupies the first place in the Central American region in guaranteeing the permanent control of the use of toxic substances in the manufacturing industry and in the agricultural sector by putting into practice the protocols established by the World Health Organization (WHO).

This [achievement] was announced on Thursday during the VIII Congress of the National Commission for Registration and Control of Toxic Substances, which took place in the Nicaraguan capital.


According to experts, the use of more than 80 industrial chemicals and pesticides that the WHO has catalogued as harmful to people's health is prohibited in Nicaragua.

Representatives of the Ministry of Health (MINSA) and the Institute of Agricultural Protection and Health (IPSA) and the Ministry of Environment and Natural Resources (MARENA) participated in the Congress.

María Auxiliadora Díaz, president of the National Commission for the Regime and Control of Toxic Substances, said that the Congress was intended to publicize the advances being achieved in the implementation of controls of chemical products [throughout the country].

First Commissioner Francisco Diaz Madriz meets with Chinese Security Minister

The Director General of the National Police of Nicaragua, First Commissioner Francisco Javier Diaz Madriz, held on Wednesday, 20 September 2023, a Bilateral Meeting with Brother Wan Xiaohong, Minister of Public Security of the People's Republic of China, during which they discussed various issues relating to Public Security of both countries.

In this important bilateral meeting, they discussed the possibility of establishing Cooperation and Collaboration Agreements between our Peoples and Governments, for the training of the Nicaraguan National Police in matters of public security, crime prevention and investigation, as well as the provision of police techniques and technologies for the fight against Organized Crime, International Drug Trafficking, Cybercrime and Terrorism.

For his part, First Commissioner Francisco Javier Díaz Madriz, proposed an exchange of experiences and best practices of our successful Policing Model for the Protection of Individuals, Families and Community.

Nicaragua also participated in the Global Cooperation Forum on Public Security in Lianyungang, People's Republic of China, which took place from Tuesday, 19 to Thursday, 21 September 2023.

Attorney General's Office: 652,162 property titles have been issued in Nicaragua since 2007

The Government of Nicaragua, in order to provide legal security to Nicaraguan families, has, through the Attorney General's Office [Procuraduría General de la República, PGR], delivered 652,162 property titles since 2007, issuing an average of 2,500 legal documents per week.

Wendy Carolina Morales Urbina, Attorney General of the Republic, during the morning show En Vivo described in detail the work that is being carried out to legalize [ownership of] properties nationwide, as part of the Government's efforts to respond to the needs of families.

"This work is occurring daily through different communications with the population, because in fact the work we are carrying out includes the weekly delivery of property titles, specifically 2,500 titles are being delivered weekly nationwide. We are alternating work in different municipalities to make progress in the collection of the new titles that are being issued", she assured.

The Attorney General of the Republic indicated that in this year 2023 a little more than 37,000 property titles have been delivered to families throughout the country. "I always emphasize the number of titles because it is important to show the Nicaraguan people how much progress is being made in titling matters".
