On Monday, 2 October, in the State Duma of the Russian Federation, a ceremony was held for the establishment of the Commission for Russian-Nicaraguan Parliamentary Cooperation.

The ceremony was presided over by Comrade Vyacheslav Volodin, chairman of the Duma, together with vice-chairmen and heads of working committees and by Compañero Laureano Ortega Murillo, Special Representative of the President of Nicaragua for Russian Affairs, together with the Nicaraguan Parliamentary and Ministerial Delegation that attended the First Parliamentary Forum Russia-Latin America.

Afterwards, they held the first working session of the Commission in which the priority areas of bilateral cooperation between Nicaragua and Russia were discussed, highlighting topics such as Health, Transport, Agriculture, Energy, Trade and Investment, Financial Cooperation, and the Struggle against Hegemony and External Interference.

Both countries emphasized the historic relationship of friendship and brotherhood between Nicaragua and Russia and the importance of expanding and strengthening all areas of work.

Nicaragua and Belarus hold third meeting of the Joint Commission in the city of Minsk

On Tuesday, 3 October, in the city of Minsk, the third meeting of the Joint Commission between Nicaragua and Belarus for economic and trade exchange, as well as scientific and technical cooperation took place.

The Commission was chaired by Mr. Eugeny Shestakov, Deputy Minister of Foreign Affairs of Belarus, and by Mr. Ivan Acosta, Minister of Finance and Public Credit of the Republic of Nicaragua. Representatives of ministries, banks, companies, business and industrial chambers, theaters and institutes of science and technology participated on behalf of Belarus.

During the meeting, plans for the implementation of cooperation projects and programs in the sectors of export credits, supply of construction machinery, municipal cleaning and road maintenance machinery, trade and investment, agriculture, agroindustry, light industry, health and pharmaceutical sector, culture, education and municipal twinning were discussed.

Nicaragua's Minister of Finance: Our country could become a transshipment hub

Nicaragua could become an important transshipment hub for the supply of Belarusian products to markets in Central and Latin America, said Nicaraguan Minister of Finance and Public Credit, Mr. Ivan Acosta Montalvan after a meeting of the Belarusian-Nicaraguan Joint Commission for Economic and Trade Cooperation in Minsk, BelTA reports.

According to Acosta, "the results of the Commission's work will be very tangible and will be seen, above all, in trade exchange, the volume of which will [undoubtedly] increase. For its part, Nicaragua will become a transshipment hub for the supply of Belarusian products to the markets in Central and Latin America." He explained that Nicaragua is geographically located between the Pacific and Atlantic oceans and will utilize three major ports. "In January 2024 Nicaragua will start operating a port for goods from China. There is a major port for goods from North America and another one for European countries. For Belarus we have a very good platform. We have great prospects", the minister stressed.

According to Acosta, at the meeting of the Joint Commission in Minsk, the parties discussed, first of all, possible supply of Belarusian machinery to Nicaragua, as well as investments in various sectors. The development of exchanges in the cultural, scientific, technical and humanitarian spheres was also discussed.

250 buses from the People's Republic of China arrive in Managua

In order to continue renewing the fleet of public transportation vehicles for the benefit of its population, 250 buses from the People's Republic of China arrived in Managua, capital of Nicaragua, on Monday afternoon.

2 October the Vice-president of On Nicaragua, Compañera Rosario Murillo during her morning briefing, said: "Keep in mind that we have or will be receiving a total of 1,500 buses in the next few months from the People's Republic of China. Next month another 250 will be delivered. With these first 250 buses we will completely replace the total fleet of Ciudad Sandino. The public transport of Ciudad Sandino, with 133 buses, is organized in six transport cooperatives that connect this municipality with Managua, the capital city. The fleet of buses in Managua itself will also be expanded by incorporating distributed among 16 117 new buses cooperatives".

Raymundo Flores, mayor of Ciudad Sandino, commenting on the bus fleet that will arrive in his municipality stated "In the first place, this will generate greater security, greater comfort for the residents of Ciudad Sandino, especially those who travel to the municipality of Managua, where a large part of the population commutes to their jobs, to what is the [metropolitan] Capital".
