**NICARAGUA RECEIVES FOOD DONATION

80.9% of Nicaraguans believe that President Daniel Ortega is a democratic ruler.

The results from the third SISMO survey of M&R Consultores, corresponding to the third quarter of the year 2023, show that 80.9 percent of the population believe that President Daniel Ortega's style of government reflects a democratic ruler, who adheres to the laws of the country.

Raúl Obregón, general manager of M&R Consultores, informed that 89.1 percent of those interviewed consider that the government of President Daniel Ortega works for the welfare of the people.

77.2 percent of those interviewed consider that the Government works for the benefit of the population, without discrimination.

In addition, 80.6 percent of those surveyed said that President Daniel Ortega seeks unity and reconciliation among Nicaraguans.

Moreover, 80.2 percent of those interviewed consider that President Ortega's government is taking the country in the right direction.

Declaration of the National Assembly of Nicaragua

Government of Nicaragua announces delivery of buses, credits and housing

The Government of Nicaragua announced the delivery of buses to drivers, credits to finance businesses and houses to families as part of the New Victories Program, informed Compañera Rosario Murillo, Vice President of the Republic during her daily briefing.

"Here we are working hard with pride to serve the families of Nicaragua, our blessed people, our blessed homeland. We are always moving forward in peace and affection, in peace and well-being, in peace and legal security, [defending] the right of all Nicaraguan families to live with well-being", said Compañera Rosario.

She announced that the buses would be delivered on the 13th of October, the anniversary of the beginning of the Sandinista Popular Insurrection in San Carlos, Ocotal, then in Masaya in the next few days".

She explained that 250 buses will be delivered tomorrow to 250 drivers, brothers and sisters in the municipalities of Managua and Ciudad Sandino.

"Then we will also deliver credits under the Program Adelante, in 17 departments tomorrow, 64 municipalities, in the main cities of these departments. This includes credits to finance more businesses and more production," she said.

"And on Tuesday the 17th, we will also deliver 300 new homes in the Camino del Río housing development located in Sábana Grande. And on Monday the 23rd, we will deliver the first 50 houses in Mirador Xolotlán housing development located in District 2 of Managua. We are moving forward towards new victories!", she said.

Minister Iván Acosta to present the General Budget of the Republic for 2024

The Government of Nicaragua, through the Minister of Finance and Public Credit, Compañero Iván Acosta, will present the General Budget of the Republic for 2024, before the First Secretariat of the Board of Directors of the National Assembly, highlighted Vice President Compañera Rosario Murillo.

"Today in the afternoon, before the weekend or already on Friday afternoon, Compañero Iván Acosta, our Minister of Finance, will appear before the First Secretariat of the National Assembly, in compliance with the deadlines established by law. He will present, on behalf of our President, the General Budget of the Republic for 2024", she said.

She added "we are always confident that we live under a sun that illuminates us and that does not wane, and that this sun is already shining upon all our new victories. We will cover the presentation of the Budget to bring it to TV screens of families all over Nicaragua".

"Next week the budget will be presented in the plenary of the National Assembly and in the Economic Commission, also of the National Assembly", she said.

Nicaragua receives food donation from the Russian Federation

Nicaragua received through the World Food Program (WFP), a donation of wheat flour and sunflower vegetable oil from the Russian Federation.

The ceremony was presided over by Laureano Ortega Murillo, Presidential Advisor for Investment Promotion, Trade and International Cooperation; Professor Lilliam Herrera, Minister of Education; Mr. Alexander Khokholikov, Ambassador of the Russian Federation in Nicaragua; Mrs. Giorgia Testolin, WFP Country Director and representative; and Ivan Acosta, Minister of Finance and Public Credit.

The delivery of the food donation is targeted for the school lunches for boys and girls during the 2024 school year. The donation was made at the warehouses of ENABAS Los Brasiles, located at kilometer 18 ½ Carretera Nueva a León highway.

Ambassador Alexander Khokholikov said that in this food donation Russia delivered 172 tons of wheat flour and "more than 300 tons of sunflower oil, for an estimated value of more than 2 million dollars".

Khokholikov emphasized that this humanitarian program has been successfully carried out for several years thanks to the strategic partnership of the Russian Federation and the sister Republic of Nicaragua.
