Rubén Darío in the Splendid Azure of Universal Literature and Culture

MONDAY, 6 FEBRUARY 2023

On 6 February 1916, 107 years ago today, Rubén Darío, the "Prince of Castilian Literature", Hero of Cultural Independence and a National Hero, died in the city of León. Poet, journalist and diplomat, he is considered the greatest representative of literary modernism in the Spanish language. He is buried in the Cathedral of Leon. Today Nicaragua honors its poet.

"That Rubén who is in the enormous, splendid Firmament of Literature and Universal Culture. That... 'our' Rubén who so fills our Heart and makes us swell with so much Pride, that grows every day... A National Honor! "

After his stay in New York, where the dramatic final days of Rubén Darío, sick and fatigued, were already foreshadowed, the poet arrived in Guatemala, already in search of his homeland. His wife Rosario Murillo came to bring him, and after traveling by steamship and train, he arrived in Managua on 14 December 1915.

TUESDAY, 7 FEBRUARY 2023

The National System of Production, Consumption and Trade develops programs and policies that provide technical support to producer families, promoting the incorporation of new varieties and technologies, efficient irrigation systems and phytosanitary surveillance of crops, which all contribute to boost the local and family economy and increase national production for Food Security.

National vegetable production for the months of February and March 2023, indicates a good harvest, mainly onion, green peppers, cabbage, and carrots, with sufficient volumes to supply domestic consumption:

Green pepper: For February, a harvest output of 57,267 quintals has been recorded and for March, 53,910 quintals are expected.

Carrots: 34,872 quintals were harvested in February and 52,576 quintals are expected to be harvested in March.

Nicaragua deports 222 traitors of the Fatherland

THURSDAY, 9 FEBRUARY 2023

From the Judicial Complex in Managua, Magistrate Octavio Rothschuh Andino, president of Chamber One of the Court of Appeals of Managua (TAM) read the official announcement on the immediate and already effective deportation of 222 persons sentenced for committing acts that undermine the independence, sovereignty and self-determination of the people, for inciting violence, terrorism and economic destabilization.

At 8:30 this morning, February 9th, Magistrate Octavio Rothschuh Andino, president of Chamber One of the Court of Appeals of Managua (TAM), read the sentence.

"Pursuant to Articles 1, 2, 3, 24, 34 and 9 of the Political Constitution of Nicaragua, Articles 31, 409, 410, 412, 413, of Law 641 of the Penal Code, Law 1055, Law for the Defense of the Rights of the People to Independence, Sovereignty and Self-Determination for Peace, in this case to protect Peace, National Security, Public Order, Health, Public Morals, Rights and Liberty of Third Parties, the sentenced persons who for different illicit acts violated the legal and constitutional order, threatening the State of Nicaragua and the Nicaraguan society, harming the supreme interest of the nation. Therefore, the immediate and effective deportation of 222 persons is ordered," he read.

Dr. Gustavo Porras: Constitutional Reform is a decision for peace in Nicaragua

FRIDAY, 27 FEBRUARY 2023

Doctor Gustavo Porras, president of the National Assembly, during an interview in En Vivo Magazine, assured that the approval during the first legislature of the reform to article 21 of the Constitution of the Republic which establishes that any traitor to the Homeland loses the status of national was a decision whose fundamental objective was to seek peace in Nicaragua.

"We feel that, in this country, today we woke up with a much calmer environment, much less heavy [atmosphere].... The vocation for peace, of the Nicaraguan people, the vocation for peace of President Daniel, of Compañera Rosario, is surprising and is what makes these decisions, decisions of the Nicaraguan people, decisions of the Nicaraguan Government. With magnanimity, an attitude of certitude of an absolutely correct decision, we are clear that these are all terrorists; they are people who destroyed or tried to destroy our country, [they] murdered Nicaraguans.

They have no forgiveness from God, because God is going to judge all these actions in the end. However, we must give witness and God has shown us this path. We must show that we are people, as President Daniel has taught us, people with serenity, with vision, with criteria, with the capacity to forgive and to seek peace. Our main objective is to seek peace, to move forward the economy of our country, to move forward the well-being of all Nicaraguans", he said.
