Second issue of the Scientific Journal of Education of Nicaragua

Monday, **[various** institutional presented partners] the second publication of the Scientific Journal of Education of Nicaragua dedicated highlighting the progress, achievements and challenges of the modalities of Primary, Secondary, Technical Schools and University Education in the Field through research, articles, essays and interviews. The Scientific Journal is a joint collaboration between the Ministry of Education, the Regional Autonomous Education System of the Caribbean Coast, the National Technological Institute and the National Council of Universities (known by its Spanish acronym CNU).

In his presentation, Compañero Salvador Vanegas explained that the journal allows for documenting in real time and through the voices of the protagonists themselves, the evolutionary transformation of Nicaraguan education led by President Daniel Ortega and Vice-President Rosario Murillo.

Professor Orlando Pineda and Dr. Edgard Palazio Galo commented on the educational and academic content of the Journal, highlighting the 'Secondary Education Strategy', as well as the 'University in the

Countryside' [Universidad en el Campo] and the creation of Nicaragua's first Indigenous University of Agriculture and Livestock, located in the Tiktik kaanu community in the South Caribbean Coast.

The launch took place in the municipality of San Francisco Libre, Managua, and included the participation of the authors of the articles, research teams, students and teachers from MINED, INATEC and CNU.

The Scientific Journal of Education of Nicaragua, known as "Índice", is a periodical specializing in research and the promotion of Nicaraguan Education. It also promotes academic exchanges and debate at the national and international level.

Millionaire investment in water and sanitation projects Managua

Tuesday, 21 June 2022

In the second half of the year, ENACAL will execute simultaneously a series of drinking water and sanitation projects, which will improve the quality of life of thousands of Nicaraguan families.

"We have 34 projects more or less in progress, in practically the same number of cities. In this first semester, we are nearly reaching the end of the first semester, we were able to begin a series of projects including the Las Sabanas drinking water project in Madriz; the Quilali drinking water project and the Wiwilí-Jinotega drinking water project, three very important ventures that are being developed with the Inter-American Development Bank", said the Executive President of ENACAL, Ervin Barreda.

He pointed out that the Ciudad Darío-Las Calabazas sanitary sewerage project, in the department of Matagalpa, and the Telica sanitary sewerage project, in the department of León, have already begun.

"And we were also able to start construction of two family care centers in Leon and here in Managua in the sector of Altamira", he said. Engineer Barreda emphasized that work continues on 13 other drinking water projects, seven of which are more than 80% completed in San Juan del Sur, Moyogalpa, Altagracia and Nueva Guinea.

When these projects are completed, we will be benefiting 156,319 families, and if we multiply that by six, we are talking about almost 800,000 people who will have sewage systems for perhaps the first time, in most of these places, they will have sewer systems for the first time ever.

In this regard, Barreda expressed that they are talking about 21 sewerage projects that are being implemented, but in what remains of the second half of 2022 they will be working to begin the drinking water project in Jinotepe.

He informed that they will be signing the contract next week at the latest. There will be 12,842 families and it will solve a very important drinking water problem for families in Jinotepe.

he new Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of the People's Republic of China, Chen Xi, arrived in Nicaragua with the commitment to continue strengthening cooperation ties in favor of both nations.

The ambassador of the People's Republic of China was received at the international airport by Presidential Advisor for Investment, Trade and International Cooperation, Laureano Ortega Murillo.

The presidential advisor, Laureano Ortega, conveyed to the Ambassador of the People's Republic of China, the warm and fraternal welcome on behalf of President Daniel Ortega and Vice President Rosario Murillo.

"To convey our gratitude to President Xi Jinping, to his government, to his people, for the recent appointment of this Ambassador, who will be here and will strengthen the cooperation with our government and people," Ortega said.

He recalled that since 9 December 2021, when Nicaragua reestablished diplomatic relations with the People's Republic of China, they have been cooperating in various programs of mutual benefit to our peoples. He reiterated the friendship, fraternal cooperation and desire to strengthen ties in all possible fields with the People's Republic of China.

Ambassador Xi expressed his gratitude for the warm welcome and conveyed the greetings of the People's Republic of China.

"The Nicaraguan people are courageous, heroic and glorious. It is a great honor for me to serve as the first ambassador of the People's Republic of China to Nicaragua after the restoration of our diplomatic relations. We appreciate the one-China stance of the Government of Nicaragua," Xi said.

Nicaragua expresses interest to Russia in increasing investment and economic agreements

Thursday, 23 June 2022

The Minister of Finance and Public Credit, Iván Acosta, upon his return after participating as a member of the Nicaraguan delegation in the St. Petersburg International Economic Forum, said that the trip allowed Nicaragua to put on the table matters of national interest such as investment and economic agreements.

"It is a forum that brings together world leaders. Since 2008 we have been participating because it is a great opportunity to attract investment, bring our products to markets and promote exchanges to mobilize technology from producing countries to consuming countries," said the minister.

"For Nicaragua, in addition to participating in the [St. Petersberg] forum, the event also provided us with an important opportunity to strengthen bilateral relations between the Russian Federation and Nicaragua. In particular, as part of this strengthening, we had the opportunity to meet with Dr. Veronika Skvortsova," said the Minister of Finance and Public Credit. "And we reviewed the bilateral portfolio, the portfolio of projects, activities, agreements that we are currently developing with the Russian Federation on issues such as the annual purchases of wheat, what we are currently negotiating is renewing the agreement; the acquisition of buses, there are already 300 buses in the port of St. Petersburg ready to be shipped to the port of Corinto", he continued informing.

"Annually there are 120 to 130 thousand tons of wheat and what we are negotiating is an annual program for a commercial exchange at a fair price in order to be able to transfer that fair price to the baking industry so that it also results in a positive impact on consumer prices", he pointed out.

In addition, the Minister mentioned that they discussed Nicaragua's interest in importing machinery for production and furthering topics related to nuclear energy for peaceful purposes that are applied to agriculture, medicine and meteorology.

Ceremony to commemorate the 86th anniversary of the birth of Comandante Carlos Fonseca

Friday, 24 June 2022

President Daniel Ortega and Vice President Rosario Murillo presided over a ceremony in commemoration of the 86th anniversary of the birth of the father of the Sandinista Popular Revolution, Comandante Carlos Fonseca Amador.

The Sandinista Youth of July 19th were present at the ceremony, which took place in front of the mausoleum where the remains of the founder of the Sandinista Front rest, in the Plaza de la Revolución.

Commander Daniel Ortega in his message highlighted that the month of June is a period of great battles throughout the history of Nicaragua, Latin America, the Caribbean and the world.

"How many acts of heroism occurred [in June] in Nicaragua, in Latin America and the Caribbean, all over the world. The world is full of heroic deeds, of feats and this is how we have been advancing throughout the history of humanity in the struggle for peace and to achieve peace. We have the struggle for sovereignty and with sovereignty, not only is there peace, the door to justice opens, the doors to freedom are opened, the doors to healthcare, education, eradication of poverty are all opened. These are the great stakes, the great challenges that confronted humanity and that humanity still faces in these times", said the Sandinista leader.

President Ortega highlighted that Comandante Carlos Fonseca Amador was born during these days in the month of June and his immortal remains are accompanied by Comandante Tomás Borge and Colonel Santos López, who is the vital link between the struggle of General Augusto C. Sandino and the continuation of that struggle which made possible the birth of the Sandinista National Liberation Front.

President Ortega indicated that the great challenge for Latin American and Caribbean peoples is to achieve the unity of the Central American peoples. "We are brothers, we were born together in the struggle against the Spanish conquest, in the resistance against the invaders, in our battles against Yankee expansionism. And it was Central America, with Nicaragua at the head, that defeated the filibusters here in Nicaragua".
